

Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival Welsh Language Policy / Statement

Aims

Safeguarding and promoting the Welsh language and its use in all areas of Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival activities.

In dealing with the public, Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival will treat Welsh and English on the basis of equality. Both languages will enjoy the same status and validity.

By doing so Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival will:

- offer the public the right to choose the language to use in their dealings with Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival.
- recognising that members of the public can express their views and needs, better in their preferred language;
- recognising that enabling the public to use their preferred language is a matter of good practice, not a concession;
- recognising that denying people the right to use their preferred language could place them at a real disadvantage.

Written correspondence

The public will be welcomed to deal with Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival, in writing either in Welsh or in English. Correspondence will be answered and signed by Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival in the language of the original correspondence.

When Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival initiate correspondence, the preferred language of the addressee will be used if known; if not the correspondence should begin` in bilingual form.

Any circular or standard letter to the public will be in bilingual form.

Telephone Communication

People are welcome to speak Welsh or English when dealing with 'Gŵyl Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival on the telephone.

Public Meetings



At public meetings organised by Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival anyone is welcome to speak Welsh or English as they prefer, dependent on the room where the meeting is to be held, mobile translation facilities will be used, provided suitable funding is available.

The public will be informed at such meetings that translation equipment is available and that they are welcome to use their preferred language.

Advertising and Publicity

Where Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival publicises its activities within Wales it will do so bilingually. When these activities are held by Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival or in its name, the display materials and any supporting material such as advertisements, posters, publicity, literature and videotapes will be fully bilingual.

Sponsorship and grants

In the case of organisations, bodies or individuals with whom Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival will co-operate or in the case of partnership between Gwyl fwyd a diod Caernarfon food and drink festival and any other organisation, body or individual, such projects or partnerships will provide bilingual services to the public.
